AGE LIMITS

4 weeks - 11 years

- Parents MUST remain in building.
- Maximum time limit is two hours.
- For safety reasons, if the nursery has reached maximum occupancy, service may be denied or delayed.
- Please take your child to the bathroom or change child's diaper. Staff does not change diapers.
- Child must be able to handle all bathroom needs. If he/she cannot, staff will locate you to take your child to the washroom.
- Please fill out ALL information on Nursery sign-in sheet.
 - Child's first and last name
 - Child's age
 - Amount paid
 - Time checked in
 - Time expected to check out
 - Where to locate you
- Label your child's belongings.
- Absolutely NO FOOD IN NURSERY.
 - Bottles and sippy cups MUST be labeled and filled with water only. Juice boxes and juice in sippy cups or bottles are not permitted.
- Please have an updated emergency card on file at each facility used.
- Please check for posted nursery hours. Hours may change.
- Appropriate behavior is necessary for the safety of all children.
 - Time-outs will be used to address behavioral problems.
- If a problem arises with your child, staff will locate you.
- Schaumburg Park District reserves the right to close the nursery due to special events.
- Staff does not bottle feed children.
- Anyone more than 10 minutes late will be charged for an additional 1/2 hour.
- Children able to move on their own must wear shoes/socks.
- Parents must abide by the sick child policies.
- The same parent must drop off and pick up child.
- Parents will be asked to remove a child who cannot be comforted from crying after 15 minutes.
- Schaumburg Park District is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

SICK CHILD POLICY

If a child becomes sick while at the center, he/she will have to be picked up by the parent immediately.

A child with any of the following conditions or behaviors may be refused:

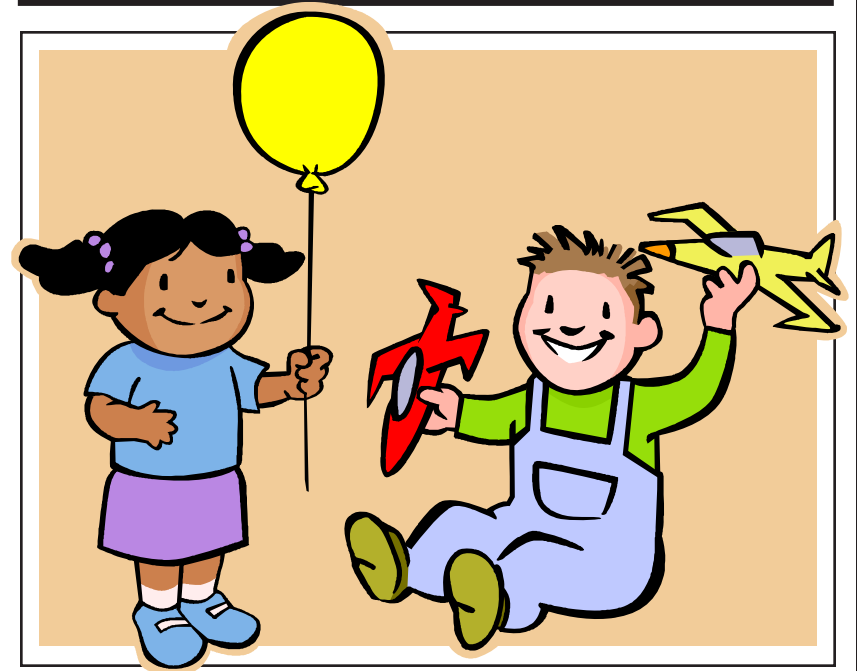
- Bad cough.
- Profusely runny nose. If staff has to wipe your child's nose more than three times, you will be asked to remove your child.
- A 99 degree Fahrenheit or higher temperature.
- A bacterial infection such as strep throat or impetigo and has not completed 24 hours of antimicrobial therapy.
- Vomited within the last 24 hours.
- Abnormally loose stools within the previous 24 hours.
- Contagious conjunctivitis (pink eye) pus draining from the eye.
- Unexplained lethargy.
- Lice, ringworm or scabies that is untreated and contagious to others.
- An undiagnosed rash or a rash attributable to a contagious illness or condition.
- A reportable illness or condition that a physician determines has not had sufficient treatment to reduce risk to others.
- Chicken pox (the child is no longer infectious) until the lesions are crusted over.
- All cuts, scrapes, sores and warts must be covered with a bandage.

If your child exhibits any of these symptoms, please keep him or her home. Please understand staff is watching out for all the children.
